### WHITE MARSH SPRING FISHING DERBY

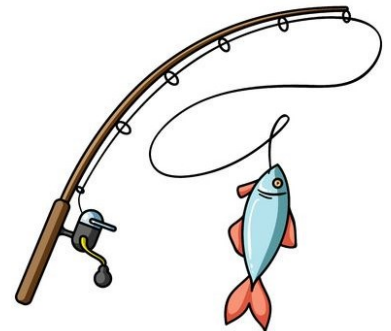

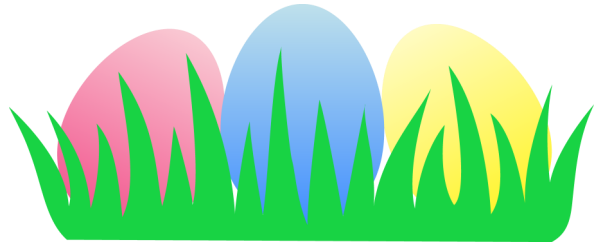
